WVARSE LEGISLATIVE GOALS 2016-2017

- · That WVARSE will promote legislation to continue and maintain the quality of PEIA coverage, without increases in premiums and copays or reduction in benefits.
- That WVARSE supports recommendations of House Concurrent Resolu-
- That WVARSE supports legislation excluding state pensions from West Virginia state income taxes. That WVARSE will work to amend legislation to provide a monthly supple-
- ment to all retirees equal to \$1.00 times years of service. · That WVARSE supports legislation which restores the exclusion of \$2000.00 that is lost when a retiree reaches age 65.
- That WVARSE will promote legislation to establish a 1/2% severance tax on Marcellus and Utica Gas as a funding source for retiree benefits.
- That WVARSE will promote legislation to establish a 1/2% tax on any future cracker plant as a funding source for retiree benefits

PEIA

The only change in benefits for retirees for 2017 is the elimination of coverage for Acupuncture and the elimination of the \$4 discount on premiums for end-of -life procedure. There is an 8% increase in premium effective January 2017. The 2018 plan will be addressed in a future issue. PEIA has a shortfall for 2018 which will result in changes in both premiums and benefits unless funding is included in the FY18 budget. Your constant contact with your Legislators is important.
